The application for acceptance as doctoral student should also include your:

1. **Curriculum vitae (CV)**
2. **Copy of the university degree certificate**
3. **Online registration / enrolment**

An **online registration in TUCaN** is **mandatory** for studying for a doctorate at TU Darmstadt; an online enrolment as a doctoral student is optional.

Do not get confused by terms such as “application / online application”. For technical reasons, these terms are used both for registration and enrolment as a doctoral student.

After completing the online application form, a request for registration / enrolment will be generated by the portal. Add this request to the documents 1 to 3 stated above.

When all documents are complete, please submit them to the Departmental Office in **both paper and electronic form**. The electronic version should be sent to dekanatsassistenz@gugw.tu-darmstadt.de.

You will be notified of the Doctoral Admissions Committee's decision in due course.
